**TRINITY SUNDAY** Theme: The Gift of God in Three Persons.

The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity celebrates the Three Persons in God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit. God has abundantly revealed himself as the Father who creates, the Son who redeems and saves and the Holy Spirit who sanctifies. Our Salvation is assured because of the three persons yet with One nature, essence and divine substance.

God's love for humanity moves him to give his Son for the salvation of all who believes in him. God's purpose for sending his Son was to save the world and not to condemn it. God condemns no one. God's offer of salvation through his Son is a gift, which must be received by faith. We must believe in the one through whom salvation is to be achieved.
