


From the desk of Fr Jerry. SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

We continue our journey to Easter through a high mountain of Prayer. Mountain signifies a place of prayer. We are usually satisfied and comfortable with our comfort zone and always find it difficult and sometimes painful to venture into the unknown. The Transfiguration of Jesus Christ invites us to move from our environment of comfort and security like Abraham to a territory, which is unknown and may sometimes entail suffering.

Jesus Christ revealed his glory to the inner circle of his disciples. Peter was so overjoyed and overwhelmed that he wanted to secure and savour his comfort zone and remain there forever; "Lord it is wonderful for us to be here". Jesus Christ reminded them of the mission ahead, a mission that entailed suffering and crucifixion.

Let us remember that Christ has not called us to a life of comfort or to secure our comfort zones. He has called us to embrace the gospel of life. Before the glory of the resurrection, our lives as Christians will entail various degrees of discomfort, pain and suffering. Let us move away from our comfort zones and venture to the unknown with Christ; for such a movement will be filled with the blessing of the Lord.
