From the desk of Fr Jerry. EASTER SUNDAY. "....he must rise from the dead...."

"The great gift of Easter is hope – Christian hope which makes us have that confidence in God, in his ultimate triumph, and in his goodness and love, which nothing can shake."- Basil C. Hume.

On this Easter Sunday, we celebrate Christ's victory over sin and death. We sing and even shout "Alleluia" to the Jesus Christ, who suffered, died on the cross, was buried, rose triumphantly and brought new life to creation.

The empty tomb alone is not an enough proof for us Christians that the Lord has risen. It serves to gradually bring us to faith in the Lord's words that he will suffer, die and rise again. Mary of Magdala is clearly baffled about the empty tomb and fails to believe in the resurrection like Peter. She obviously concludes that the body might have been taken away. Nevertheless, the positioning of the linen cloth and the head cloth cannot substantiate an action by grave looters. It is important for us to note that in the midst of the confusion, it is the beloved disciple, the paradigm of faith for all believers who "sees and believes". He sees the positioning of the linen cloth and the head cloth and concludes that the Lord has risen. Like the beloved disciples, Christians are to undertake the journey of coming to believe in the Lord who is risen. May the resurrection of Christ set us free from the spirit of Hopelessness.
