Confessions and Exposition

Fr Jerry's Advent Reflections. FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT.

Prayer Advocates' Intention to pray for all expectant mothers.

As the period of Advent gradually draws to a close we are reminded today that Emmanuel, God is with us to share in our lives and save us and we need to trust in him. Matthew relates the manner of Jesus' birth. He stresses the divine conception of Jesus through the agency of the Holy Spirit. Joseph, being a man of honour, decides to divorce Mary informally for he knows that he is not responsible for the pregnancy. The irony is that being a man of honour, Joseph had to insist on following the dictates of the Law, that is, Mary should be stoned for playing the adulteress (c.f Duet. 22:20-21). Joseph, however, tempers justice with compassion. He decides to divorce her quietly. The angel of the Lord then explains to Joseph in a dream why Mary is not an adulteress. The name 'Jesus' to be given to the child means "saviour" or "God saves". He is the one to save his people from their sins. This to fulfil the promise of the Lord through his prophet Isaiah: "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son and they will call him Emmanuel, meaning, God is with us". The meaning of the name which will appear at the end of the book implies the ever presence of God with his people.

God wants to share intimately in human history and in our human condition. He therefore chooses to be the Emmanuel, God with us. With faith in him let us allow the Lord to enter into our human condition, for he is always with us.

Confessions: Fr Jerry will be at St Anselm's on Saturday 24 December between 2-3pm to hear confessions. There will also be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at the same time.

Prayer during Mass. Fr Jerry would like to us all to pray the prayer to Our Lady of Perpetual Succour at the end of the Prayers of the Faithful, in place of the Hail Mary.

Family Christmas Mass: There will be a family Christmas Mass at Sacred Heart at 5:30pm on Christmas Eve. Children are invited to come to this Mass dressed as any character in the Nativity story.

Donations to Food Banks. The SVP would like to thank everyone for the volume of Food Bank donations received over the last few weeks. We split the many items received between the two Food Banks in Northampton and we have had a very nice response and an expression of surprise that so much had been collected by two relatively small churches.
