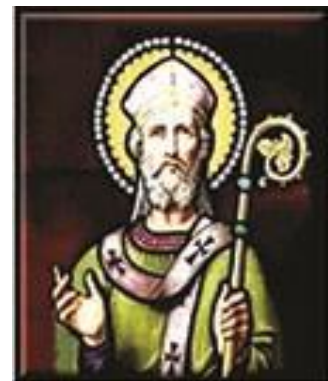

Change in Mass Schedule. At a recent meeting of the Pastoral Area team, which comprises of the priests in our Pastoral Area and the laity, it was agreed to recommend to the Bishop that the number of Sunday Masses at Our Lady's should reduce from two to one. Following that consultation with Bishop Peter, it is with much regret that the 11.30am Mass will therefore no longer be said, with the last Mass being said on Sunday 31 July 2016. We appreciate that this will have a significant impact on those parishioners who regularly attend at this time and will affect both the parish and the Shrine. Decisions like this are not taken lightly and we would ask that parishioners accept this change in a prayerful and understanding way. We will have an opportunity to discuss it our Parish Open Meeting on 11 July.

Parish Meeting. You are invited to a Parish Meeting in the Institute at Great Billing on Monday 11 July at 6.45pm (following Mass at 6pm). All parishioners of Our Lady's and St Anselm's are welcome to attend. The meeting will be led by the Parish Team and Fr Jerry will be joining us. The meeting is an opportunity for you to comment on life today in our parish and how we might work together in making adjustments for inevitable change in the future.

From Fr Jerry. I have noticed that some parishioners leave Mass before the Final Blessing and, occasionally, immediately after Communion. I understand that life is busy, however please do not let your habits of haste pull you out of what should be an atmosphere of reflective gratitude. Please stay and obtain all the graces from the Mass.
