

Confessions at Our Lady's. We have been advised from a safeguarding point of view that confessions need to take place in a safe environment for both priest and parishioner and that our confessional in the sacristy at Our Lady's does not comply with these requirements. With exposition taking place following the 10am Mass and, until we find a more permanent solution, we have therefore decided in the short term that confessions will be held in the church garden whilst the weather is warm and Fr Jerry will make that decision each Saturday following the morning Mass and inform those attending if there will be or will not be confession that day. We appreciate this may not be the solution for everyone and therefore confessions are available at Sacred Heart also on a Saturday between 4.30pm – 5.15pm. Confessions at other times are also available at the Cathedral, St Gregory's, Wellingborough and Rushden – see web sites for details.
