

Have you registered to vote? The Government is changing the way we register to vote. The Bishops are keen that we all use our votes so if you are over 16 years old, you can register on line by going to: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote You'll need your name, address, date of birth and a few other details, like your National Insurance number (if you have one), but it's easy to do. Registration is free but if you fail to register to vote, you could face an £80 fine. You may also find it more difficult to get services like credit cards or phone contracts. You can vote once you are 18, but you can register from 16. Any British, Commonwealth, Irish or EU citizen is included. If you don't have access to the internet, then ring either Northampton Borough Council on 0300 330 7000 or East Northamptonshire Council on 01832 742119.
