**SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT.** "God has promised forgiveness to your repentance, but He has not promised tomorrow to your procrastination." - Augustine of Hippo.

### Theme: The Mission of Repentance by John the Baptist

Mark introduces two important personalities on the second Sunday of Advent. The first is John the Baptist and the second person is Jesus Christ. We have the One who prepares the WAY and the other who is the WAY. Mark's entire gospel focuses on the person of Jesus, the Son of God. He announces Jesus' gospel as the good news. His gospel is not an abstract one; he emphasizes the personality and actions of Jesus Christ and therefore keeps his story vital, active and Christ-centred.

Mark writes and introduces John the Baptist as our Lord's forerunner. Just as in ancient times, messengers went ahead of a king to announce his coming, so John announces the coming of the Messiah. John the Baptist prepared the mission of Jesus Christ. He announces repentance, forgiveness and baptism. He refers to the one who is to come as more powerful, more worthy and superior in ministry; for his baptism is only a preparatory water baptism of repentance, whereas Jesus baptizes with the Holy Spirit.

Our preparation for the coming of the Messiah on Christmas day must be one like John the Baptist. We must show repentance in our speech, in our actions, in our thoughts, and in our personality.

Our Prayer today is let me see O Lord, your mercy and give us your saving help.
