FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT (YEAR B). Theme: Be on your guard, stay awake.

Christmas preparations start with the Advent Season readings from the Gospel of Mark. Mark tells a story about a man who was travelling abroad and left his servants in charge of his affairs. His parting words to his servants were: "Be on your guard and stay awake." Jesus Christ in this story tells his listeners that He will be coming back, therefore, we should be constantly on the watch for his return. Since the Ascension, this final and ultimate revelation have been imminent. (CCC#673) Jesus by its union to the divine wisdom in the person of the Word incarnate enjoys in his human knowledge the fullness of understanding of the eternal plans he had come to reveal.(CCC#474)

What time are we living in now? We live between two comings of Christ. His first coming at Bethlehem over two thousand years ago and a time when we anticipate his second coming at the end of time when he will return in majesty and power. We live in a time of the Spirit and of the witness, but also a time still marked by 'distress' and the trial of evil, which does not spare the church and rushers in the struggles of the last days.
