5TH SUNDAY IN LENT. Theme: The hour has come for the Son of man to be glorified.

This request from the Greeks occasions a profound statement from Jesus. During the celebration of the Passover Feast, some Greeks approach Philip of Bethsaida seeking to see Jesus: "Sir we should like to see Jesus". Jesus said, the 'hour' has now arrived. The hour refers to the culmination of his ministry, which is his death and resurrection. But it is important for us to note that in John's Gospel, Jesus' suffering and death is not a disgrace and shame, rather the channel to his glorification. Jesus therefore compares his salvific death and resurrection to a single seed of wheat which falls to the ground, dies, rots, germinates, sprouts, matures and bears plenty fruits: "it remains only a single grain; but if it dies, it yields a rich harvest". Jesus is the seed and the 'hour' for his glorification is the passion, death and resurrection.

Jesus affirms this truth – his death and resurrection will yield a rich harvest – to all his disciples. The key to Jesus' disciples bearing much fruit is for them to die with Jesus. As we strive to put to death everything that stands in the way of our life, let us we will see new life springing forth from death.

If we truly want to serve Christ, if we want to be his true followers, then we must follow his path of suffering and death, which leads to glorification and the Father, will honour us.

May the Spirit lead us to die with Christ, to die to our selfishness, pride, fear and resentment so that we will bear much fruit of peace, joy and unity.
