

PENTECOST SUNDAY. Theme: The Holy Spirit will be my witness...

The Solemnity of Pentecost celebrates the outpouring of the gift of the Holy Spirit on the disciples and apostles of Jesus Christ. John describes the Holy Spirit as the Advocate, a Witness, the Spirit of truth or Counsellor who issues from both the Father and the Son. Today is also the birthday of the Church. The role of the Holy Spirit in the life of the disciples is to direct, counsel and strengthen them in the mission of life. Since in bearing witness to Jesus, the disciples cannot accomplish this task by relying on their strength and knowledge alone.

Do we think it is too late to dream again? To the spirit all creatures turn for their sanctification; all who live virtuously seek him, and are, by his influence, refreshed and help towards their own natural end.

Another name of the Spirit of God is the Spirit of truth. Jesus said, "when the spirit of truth comes he will lead you to the complete truth." The spirit is a light of understanding to every mind that discovers the light of truth. Additionally, the Holy Spirit "will lead the disciples to the complete truth" by explaining to them all that Jesus had taught them. The Paraclete will assist the disciples to grasp fully the true meaning of Jesus' words and deeds.

He will not bring any new teaching. The Holy Spirit will lead them to a fuller understanding and appreciation of Jesus' deeds and words. Though by nature he is inaccessible, yet through his generosity men and women can receive him in themselves. But all do not share him in the same measure; he distributes his power in proportion to a person's faith.

Let us always ask the Holy Spirit, our Advocate and Counsellor to direct, counsel and strengthen us to be true witnesses of Jesus Christ in our world. May he also lead us to a full understanding and appreciation of all that Jesus said and did.
