THIRTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR. Theme: Do not be afraid, only have faith.

Christ restored the life of Jairus' daughter and also healed a woman with the haemorrhage. This demonstrates the truth of the power of Jesus as a source and giver of life. Christ worked miracles not to satisfy people's curiosity but to bear witness to his divinity and to strengthen the faith of his followers.

Jairus approached Jesus with faith: "My little daughter is at the point of death. Come and lay your hands on her, so that she may be made well and live". Moved by faith, the woman suffering from haemorrhage also said: "If I can touch even his clothes, I shall be well again". Both Jairus and the woman believed that Jesus was capable of giving life. On the other hand, the people dispatched by Jairus from his household, showed little faith, doubting that Jesus had power over death.

Meanwhile, the disciples exhibited the same lack of faith, you see how the crowd is pressing round you and yet you say, "Who touched me? Jesus responds to their lack of faith and speaks to us today as well: "Do not be afraid; only have faith".

How do we perceive Jesus Christ? Is he a wonder-worker of the past? How often do we request the sacrament of the anointing of the sick? The anointing of the sick is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death but everyone who is seriously sick or persons preparing for serious surgery. However, whenever we act in jealousy, envy or bitterness, it signifies our lack of faith! Jesus wants our faith to be like Jairus or the haemorrhaging woman. He wants to tell us: "Do not fear, only have faith".
