THE BAPTISM OF THE THE LORD: Theme: You are my Son, the Beloved, my favour rests on you.

Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Saviour of the world. Who is Jesus Christ to the World? The answer to this question can be found in the Voice at Baptism...! Today we celebrate how God was manifested in Jesus through the baptism in the Jordan. "Then Jesus appears." The Baptist hesitates, but Jesus insists and receives baptism. Jesus came to John and received baptism at his hands. He who is present everywhere and is absent nowhere, incomprehensible to the angels and withdrawn from the gaze of man, has come to baptism was his good pleasure...and a voice was heard saying: You are my Son, the Beloved, my favour rest on you. "This is the manifestation (Epiphany) of Jesus as Messiah of Israel and Son of God. CCC#535

At Epiphany, we witness Christ's presentation to the World. The mission of God the Father was about Jesus Christ. The Father of immortality sent his immortal Son into the World. He was sent to women and men to wash them with Water and the Spirit.

We share intimately in the baptism of Jesus Christ. We identify ourselves with the identity of Jesus. At His baptism, Jesus Christ was permanently changed by the water of the River Jordan and the power of the Holy Spirit. It is only our Baptism Certificates that says WHO WE ARE but other academic certificates say WHAT WE HAVE!

Let us pray and bless God with a pure soul as we commit ourselves once again to building up the Kingdom of God by renewing the commitment made at our Baptism.
