THE EPIPHANY OF THE THE LORD: "We saw His star as it arose and have come to do him homage"

Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Saviour of the world. The great feast of Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (magi) from the East, together with his baptism in the Jordan and the wedding feast at Cana in Galilee. (CCC#528)

This Sunday's Epiphany is about the wise men from the East, persons of learning, who were attracted to the new baby Jesus, King of the Jews. Meanwhile, a perplexed King Herod feared for his kingship and the security of his kingdom and was bent on eliminating Jesus. It confirms the prophecy that Christ's whole was lived under the sign of persecution.

The Fathers of the Church have held that the gifts of the wise men reveal that they recognized who this baby Jesus was: Gold for his kingship; the incense in praise of God and myrrh as an ointment to soothe the sufferings of humanity. By offering these three gifts, the wise men pointed to Jesus' authority, his deity and the fact that the long-awaited salvation could only be secured through his suffering and death

Let us imitate the faith of the wise men and ask the Holy Spirit to help us pour out the wealth of our hearts before the boy Jesus, the King of the Universe.
