From the desk of Fr Jerry: EIGHTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR (Year A)

"Worry does not empty tomorrow of its sorrow. It empties today of its strength." Corrie Ten Boom.

Worry No Longer! We are sometimes consumed by anxiety, worry and fear because of our lack of trust. We fail to trust in the tremendous love of God for us. Fortunately, we gain nothing from our worry and fear. We do not eliminate all the sources of our fears; for they will always be with us and we do not increase our lifespan for all our worrying. We even reduce our lifespan. Christ reminds us that we cannot be the slave both of God and money. Divided allegiance or attention between God and money is impossible. However, slavery to God brings perfect freedom as he provides us with all that we need.

If God the Father cares for flowers in the fields, how much more will He not care for us created in his own image? We usually lack faith in God. We doubt his power to accomplish what He has promised for us. The Eucharistic assembly is invited to pray to our heavenly Father with filial boldness; GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD. We are too busy ourselves with God's kingdom, on his righteousness and obedience to him and whatever we need for our sustenance will be provided. May we dare to trust in the providence of God.
