

FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT. Theme: Rejoice, so highly favoured! The Lord is with you.

The last Sunday of Advent journey to Christmas is dedicated to Mary. The meaning of Mary's name is "excellence". Her name underscores what God intends to do in the life of this teenage girl. It is true that Mary never applied to become the Mother of the Son of God. Definitely, she had her own plans in life but God had a greater plan for her. The greeting of Angel Gabriel to Mary was: "Rejoice so highly favoured". This greeting prompted fear and inadequacy to Mary, which led to the question "how can this be since I am a virgin?" Gabriel supplies the answer by stressing the unique identity of the Son she will conceive and the working of the Holy Trinity.

The Lord was with Mary in the form of the Holy Spirit coming down upon her. The Lord was Mary in the power of the Most High covering her with its shadow. The Lord was with her in the form of the child in her womb. The gospel of Luke connects the annunciation of Jesus with the conception of John to stress how God works mysteriously among humanity.

Consequently, Mary said, "Yes" despite the all the unforeseen difficulties that will come her way in the future. In return, God gave Mary more joy and peace and hope and love than any carols of a choir.

Mary has become a model for all believers because she responded wholeheartedly to God's plan by saying; "I am the handmaid of God". In this Christmas, is God asking me to do anything that makes me feel quite not prepared? May the Joy of Mary inspire you.
