2ND SUNDAY IN LENT. Theme: There in the presence of the disciples Christ was transfigured.

The story of the Transfiguration of Jesus in Mark's Gospel follows Jesus' declaration of his impending death and resurrection. The announcement of his suffering and resurrection perplexed the disciples and somewhat scandalized them. Through the Transfiguration, Jesus reassured his disciples, strengthen their faith by a divine revelation. He gave them a glimpse of his future heavenly glory.

The Transfiguration was very important in the faith-journey of the disciples. It was a foretaste of the glorious life that awaits those who follow Jesus faithfully by carrying their cross. It was meant to refresh and encourage the disciples to continue their lives with Jesus. Peter was so overwhelmed that he said in his ecstasy: "It is wonderful for us to be here...!
