4TH SUNDAY IN LENT. Theme: God loved the World so much

God's love for humanity is undoubtedly an unchanging fact of our relationship with him. God's love for humanity remains unchanging, undiminished and everlasting. The highest point of God's love is the death of his Only Son on the cross so that just as the brazen serpent brought salvation to all who looked at it.
