THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT: Theme: Rejoice and exult with all your heart.

The message of Joy and Rejoicing on the third Sunday of Advent is very evident with a rose candle and it cannot be underestimated. The feeling of Joy expected of us from our blessed Lord is much stronger than the cheers and the joys from spectators of a football team celebrating a victory.

The book of the prophet Zephaniah speaks to the people of Judah who were suffering from the widespread practice of religious syncretism as a result of decades of toleration and acceptance of pagan worship. The prophet reminds us why God expects us to be joyful despite difficult moments. God's relationship with us is based on His victorious love and not on our sinful past.

John the Baptist continues his preaching of repentance based on generosity. He challenges the audience to a practical approach towards repentance. "He who has two coats, let him share with him who has none; and he who has food, let him do likewise". "Collect no more than is appointed you". "Rob no one by violence or by false accusation and be content with your wages". What do you imagine John the Baptist will suggest to us do on Christmas Day?

When we begin to recognize our utter dependence with respect to the Creator that become our source of joy and freedom.
