SECOND SUNDAY OF THE YEAR: Theme: "He let his glory be seen, and his disciples believe in him..."

The story of the changing of water into wine by Jesus at a wedding feast in Cana clearly demonstrates the superabundance of God's gifts. He gives these gifts to those who trust and obey him. St. Paul's emphasizes this in the second reading, saying, "All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, who distributes different gifts to different people just as he chooses." John described this story as the first of signs given by Jesus: ... to let his glory be seen.

In response to his mother's statement: "They have no wine", Jesus gave a very profound statement, "... My hour has not come yet". The 'hour' was the appointed time for the inauguration of the kingdom of God. This is the time when the will of the Father would be fulfilled. It is the time when Satan would be defeated and the forces of darkness overthrown. Mary gives us the key to understanding the text in her command to the servant, "Do whatever he tells you". It can also be said that our personal 'hour' is a time of obedience to the will of God. Let us put our trust in Jesus and he will enable us to live in obedience to the will of the Father.
