THIRD SUNDAY OF THE YEAR: Theme: Jesus, sent to bring the good news to the poor.

Generally, the gospel of St. Luke demonstrates the catholicity of the message of Christ. Although Christ came to preach to the Jews first in fulfilment of the messianic prophecies of the Old Testament, his invitation to faith, repentance, and salvation extends to all people. Today's gospel is about how St. Luke wrote his gospel so that Christians might know the truth about Jesus Christ, about His mission and his audience. While the identity of the person, called Theophilus, is uncertain, the name means "loved by God," a general greeting that could refer to any member of the Christian community. Indeed, Jesus Christ does not want us to live in bondage to fears, anxiety, bitterness or hatred.

The vision of Jesus on earth, through the power of the Holy Spirit, was to bring freedom to humanity enslaved to sin and Satan and inaugurate the Kingdom of God. Jesus has come to set us free, to release us from various forms of enslavement and to give us a brand new way of life through the power of the Holy Spirit. Christ desires to set the Church, the body of Christ, free from all physical, emotional, mental and spiritual captivity.

The message of Jesus, some two thousand years ago is still relevant and the same today. We must proclaim the good news of God's salvation to all. When we strive to say, "yes" to Christ, his message of salvation will be fulfilled today even as we listen again to him.
