**TRINITY SUNDAY: Theme:** The Holy Trinity is the complete Truth

The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity seeks to celebrate rather than to understand the Three Persons in God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Trinity is one of the mysteries that is hidden in God, which can never be known unless they are revealed by God. (CCC#237). The Catechism of the Catholic Church also teaches that the faith of all Christians rests on the Trinity. (CCC#232) This is what we await the Spirit of Truth to come in order to fulfil; but when the Spirit of truth comes he will lead us to the complete truth. Hence, we are able to articulate the truths of faith, in terms of their reference to the three persons of the Holy Trinity. (CCC#189)

In the Holy Trinity, God has abundantly revealed himself as the Father who creates, the Son who redeems and saves and the Holy Spirit who sanctifies. Jesus Christ promises us, like his disciples, the gift of the Holy Spirit, who will guide us to the complete truth. And since everything the Father has is for Jesus it implies that the Holy Spirit that Jesus will give to his disciples will also be coming from the Father. Therefore, the Holy Spirit clearly communicates and affirms the unity in the Blessed Trinity: "Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason, I told you that he will take from what is mine and declared it to you".

May the Holy Trinity that dwells through us, and with us and in us enable us to accomplish our divine mission on this earth.
