CORPUS CHRISTI: Theme: They all ate as much as they wanted...

The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ celebrates God's ever-presence in the form of bread and wine. These species are transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit in the prayer of the priest. The role of the priest, like Melchizedek, cannot be overemphasized. Jesus, the high priest, fed the crowds with God's words, healed those who needed to be cured and fed them with five loaves and two fish as much as they wanted.

In the Eucharist, Christ gives us the pledge of glory after he has passed from this world to the Father. Whenever we participate in the Holy Sacrifice, we identify ourselves with the Heart of Jesus. He sustains our strength along the pilgrimage of this life and makes us long for eternal life and also unites us even now to the church in heaven, with the Blessed Virgin Mary and all the saints. (CCC#1419) St. Paul reminds us that every time we eat this bread and drink this cup we are proclaiming the death of Christ. During the Eucharist, we perpetuate the sacrifice of Christ on the cross. Hence, the Eucharist is about what God does for us and Service of Word and Communion is what human beings do for God!

As we celebrate the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, Corpus Christ, let us eat His body and drink His blood of Jesus with much reverence, respect and a grateful heart.

We are reminded about our blessed Lord in the Eucharistic Adoration. We have the opportunity to look directly at our Saviour, at the very God who created the universe. And there, speaking to him from the quiet of our hearts, we can confide all our joys and sorrows, our hopes and our fears. Laying them down before him, we know that he will take care of us. We ought to participate in this Sacred Sacrifice in a full, active and conscious manner.
