**PENTECOST: Theme:** The Promise of another Advocate

Traditionally, the feast of Pentecost is the birthday and the inauguration of the Church. Pentecost is a day when the seven weeks of Easter had come to an end. It is also a day when Christ's Passover is fulfilled in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, manifested, given and communicated as a divine person. CCC#731

Jesus promises the ever-abiding presence of the Advocate or the Holy Spirit to those who love him and keeps his commandments: "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I and the Father will give you another Advocate who will be with you always". The mentioning of "another Advocate" implies that Jesus had been an Advocate for the disciples. However, since he was departing to the Father, there was the need for "another Advocate" in the person of the Holy Spirit to be with them forever. He will continue the mission of the Father.

Jesus also promises the indwelling of the Father and the Son with those who love him and keep his word; "... and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him". The Advocate or the Holy Spirit will also teach them everything by reminding them of all that he had told them.

May the Holy Spirit continually empower us and bring us the abundance of life in Christ Jesus.
