SIXTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR: Theme: Jesus was welcomed into the house of Mary and Martha.

Jesus discovers friendship in the house of Lazarus and his two sisters – Martha and Mary. He was always welcome in their home and as he relaxed with them, he teaches them about the kingdom of God. As a result of their friendship with them, the lives of these three were transformed. Unlike Mary who put everything aside to sit at Jesus' feet and listen to him, Martha was distracted by her responsibilities as a hostess.

In the name of friendship, Martha was honest with Jesus about her feeling towards Mary, her sister. Martha has overworked and Jesus was able to correct her. Martha perhaps did not understand at first that she was in the presence of the Son of God. If she had known, she would probably have been sitting at Jesus' feet, basking in his presence like her sister Mary.

Jesus desires to have a close friendship with us. The first step to friendship with Jesus is hospitality. We can be encouraged by the hospitality of Abraham in the first reading. Abraham's remarkable hospitality at Mamre foreshadows the annunciation of the true Son of the promise. (CCC#2571) At the end of the visit, there was a promise to the household of Abraham.

Let us befriend Jesus today in the Blessed Sacrament as we grow in our friendship with one another in this journey of faith and to be transformed into his likeness.
