**FOURTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR: Theme: "Be Sure of this: the Kingdom of God is very near"**

The core message of Jesus Christ is about the Kingdom of God. To carry out the Will of the Father, Christ inaugurated the Kingdom of heaven on earth. To achieve the will of the father, Christ gathered men to share in his own divine life. This gathering is the Church, on earth, the seed and the beginning of that Kingdom. (CCC#541)

With detailed instructions to the seventy disciples, Jesus sends out his disciples to all the towns and places to bring many people into "the family of God". (CCC#542) According to the teaching of the church, everyone is called to enter the Kingdom. The first group of people is to the children of Israel. The second group of people are the Poor and the lowly. These are to those who have accepted it with humble hearts...Jesus declared 'blessed are the poor ...theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Also, the Kingdom belongs to the "little ones". The father is pleased to reveal what remains hidden from the wise and the learned. (CCC#544)

By virtue of our baptism, we are called to put the kingdom of God first. We are to remove all obstacles or distraction that might prevent us from fulfilling the mission of the Father has been given to us. We are to proclaim the peace and love of Christ by allowing our example to inspire others. God has a mission for each one of us. As we listen carefully to the Holy Spirit, he will reveal his plan for our lives. The success of the mission of the seventy disciples marked the gradual decline of the kingdom of Satan.

As the seventy disciples return to Jesus and reported the success of their mission, so we may have to return to God, the Father, to eternity to report how we spend our earthly life some day.
